January 18 ACT Now Brown Bag Lunch, 10:54- 12:30 (lunch provided) -

This introductory session is the perfect way for students to begin to feel familiar and comfortable with the ACT test. Our presenter will give background information about college entrance exams and pointers on the best ways to get better at taking standardized tests. During the discussion of the ACT she will help answer the question - What good is it anyway?

January 26 ACT Now Practice Test, 8:00 - 12:30 (snacks provided) - Pretend this is the real thing! The best way to determine a timing strategy that works for you is to take a test under timed conditions. To get other test jitters out of the way it may also be helpful to simulate the actual test environment. Immediate self scoring will be provided. **LIMITED SPACE!**

February 1-2 ACT Test registration - Students will be invited to the library where they will follow important directions as they fill out the ACT registration materials. This is when a serious commitment to taking the test must occur. ACTC will be responsible for paying \$49.50 for each student who registers on this day.

February 20 ACT Now Turbo Camp, 9:00 - 1:30 (lunch provided) (\$25 fee to hold spot, returned when student attends camp) - This turbo charged, four hour session will provide in-depth ACT preparation with individualized feedback.
