



## NHS Junior Campus Visitation

A Call To College (ACTC) is pleased to offer juniors at Newark High School the chance to go on an official college visit. An important part of the college search process is visiting campuses to get specific information from college officials and students; to get an idea of size and setting; and to eventually, compare different colleges.

### **Schedule of visitations:**

#### Thursday, November 3

COTC/OSU-Newark (a representative from Columbus campus will also be present)

Lunch provided by colleges.

(students must meet 2 of the 3 criteria:

have a 2.0 cumulative GPA, have earned 8 or more credits and/or have no more than 8 days of absence)

#### Friday, November 4

Denison University 11:00 a.m. - 2:15 p.m.

Lunch provided by college.

(students must have a 3.0 cumulative GPA)

NOTE: Even if students are not considering attending any of the above colleges this visitation experience is valuable. ACTC recommends visiting campuses while the college is in session, and junior year is NOT too early to start.

*In some cases registration for both dates is possible.  
This MUST be determined by the student's English teacher and ACTC.*

FYI - Since A Call To College offers this visitation as a field trip, juniors at Newark High School are still allowed two other excused college visits this year. For those visits there are five easy steps to follow:

- 1) Arrange the visitation date with college admissions either by phone or online at the school's website.
- 2) Have a parent write and sign a note with the date of the visit allowing the student to go to the college, **even if student is eighteen.**
- 3) Take note to Ms. Holton in the auxiliary gym to request a college visit form. **This form needs to be approved and signed by ALL of the student's teachers.**
- 4) During the college visit have the college representative sign the NHS college visit form.
- 5) Return form the day after the college visit to Ms. Holton for an excused absence.
